## Vicente Risco Social Sciences Award



With the objectives of honouring the memory of Vicente Risco, helping to consolidate culture and strengthen relations between Galicia and Portugal and Lusophony, the municipalities of Alhariz and Castro Caldelas (Galicia), the Vicente Risco Foundation (Alhariz) and the University of Trás-os-Montes and Alto Douro (UTAD) (Vila Real - Portugal), represented by the Centre for Transdisciplinary Studies for Development (CETRAD), present the foundations of the XXIII Vicente Risco Social Sciences Award, with a taxes, of 4000 Euros and in accordance with the following clauses:

### CLÁUSULAS

#### First. –

Any person, regardless of age or nationality, who presents his or her texts in the Galician-Portuguese language, in accordance with the RAG's Orthographic and Morphological Norms and / or the Portuguese Language Orthographic Agreement, may participate in the award. The texts presented must be unpublished, totally original, not published or translated in any other format and must deal with **research related to Galicia and / or Northern Portugal**, always from the point of view of the social sciences (anthropology, sociology, history, linguistics, geography, economics, tourism ...). The research work must have a minimum length of 150 pages and a maximum length of 300 pages, DIN-A 4 size and double spaced in **Arial 12**. Special texts will be valued to suit the usual uses of the essay. Submissions deadline is October 30th, 2018.

#### Second. –

The texts must be submitted in digital format (pdf) and sent to [secretaria@fundacionvicenterisco.com](mailto:secretaria@fundacionvicenterisco.com)  
The scientific text will be presented only containing a title on its cover without authorship identification, for it requires anonymous evaluation by the jury. In another document, also submitted in digital format (pdf) and sent to [secretaria@fundacionvicenterisco.com](mailto:secretaria@fundacionvicenterisco.com), the following information will be included: Title, author's full name, Citizen's Card (CC), passport or ID, address, and e-mail. Candidates will receive official confirmation of submission.

#### Third. –

The jury of the prize will be formed by five (5) elements, related to the field of culture and social sciences, who will be nominated by the institutions that organize the award. One of them will have secretarial functions. The award for the best research presented will be awarded by a majority of votes.

#### Fourth. –

The names of the people that will be part of the jury will be announced in the first half of January 2019.

#### Fifth. –

The decision of the jury, unappealable, will be announced before the end of January 2019.

#### Sixth. –

The prize, indivisible, may be declared deserted, in case the jury considers it in a final decision.

#### Seventh. –

The winners of the prize in previous editions will not be able to compete in this edition.

#### Eighth. –

The awarded amount attributed is considered as payment of royalties, rights then transferred to the organizers, not limited by the number of copies or editions. The rights to edit the texts may be made in any language, with the possibility of assigning rights to third parties. The beneficiary of the prize will receive twenty-five (25) copies of the published work on

paper. The award-winning author also authorizes that, one year after the presentation of the prize, the publication is accessible in a free and open download from the digital platform enabled by the organizers of the prize at:

#### Ninth. –

The jury may propose up to two additional papers for publication, in case of recognized merit and acceptance by the authors. The publication does not imply economic compensation and the authors will have to allow the copyright for the first edition of the work.

#### Tenth. –

Unprompted originals will be erased. Participation in this award means acceptance of the current clauses, as well as the decisions of the jury.
